

ROMANIA DOCUMENT CHECKLIST FOR A STUDY PERMIT

Documents Required:

Valid Passport – Must be valid for at least 3 months beyond intended stay.

Acceptance Letter – From a Romanian educational institution stating program type & duration.

Financial Proof – Bank statements, sponsorship, or scholarship letter showing sufficient funds.

Health Insurance – Coverage valid in Romania for the entire stay.

Criminal Record Certificate – From home country/recent residence, translated & certified in Romanian.

Medical Certificate – Proving good health and no contagious diseases.

Passport Photos – Two recent (last 6 months) passport-sized photos.

Accommodation Proof – Lease agreement or housing confirmation from the institution.

Processing Time & Fees:

Processing Time – Up to **30 days** from application submission. Apply early to avoid delays.

Visa Fee – **€120** (may vary by nationality). Additional costs may apply for services like biometric data submission.

Expedited Processing – Available for an extra fee if faster processing is required.

Note – Visa fees are **non-refundable**, even if the application is denied. Ensure you meet all eligibility requirements and submit complete documents before applying.

Rights:

- **Stay for Duration of Studies** – Remain in Romania for the full length of your study program.
- **Work Part-Time** – Allowed under certain conditions (may require a work permit, with limits on weekly hours).
- **Healthcare Access** – Eligible for healthcare services, including emergency care and treatment.
- **Schengen Travel** – Travel within the Schengen Area for up to 90 days in any 180-day period.
- **Visa Renewal** – Can renew your study visa if eligibility criteria are met.

Obligations:

- **Enroll in Accredited Course** – Must register at an accredited Romanian institution soon after arrival.
- **Maintain Valid Visa & Registration** – Keep visa valid and stay registered with local authorities.
- **Follow Romanian Laws** – Comply with all national laws and regulations.
- **Report Changes** – Notify authorities of address or institution changes.
- **Exit After Studies** – Leave Romania after course completion unless switching to another valid visa or work permit.
