

ROMANIA DOCUMENT CHECKLIST FOR A TOURIST VISA

1. Visa Application Form

- Fill out the online application on the official Romania eVisa portal: <https://evisa.mae.ro/>
- Print and sign the completed application form.

2. Valid Passport

- Original passport valid for at least 3 months beyond your intended stay.
- Must have minimum 2 blank pages.
- Attach copies of the bio-data page and previous visas (if any).

3. Passport-Sized Photos

- Two recent color photographs (size 3.5 cm x 4.5 cm).
- White background, full face visible.

4. Travel Itinerary

- Round-trip flight reservation or travel ticket showing entry and exit from Romania.
- (Do *not* buy actual tickets until the visa is approved.)

5. Proof of Accommodation

- Hotel booking confirmation OR
- Invitation letter from a host in Romania (if staying with family/friends).

6. Proof of Financial Means

- Recent bank statements (last 3 months) showing sufficient funds.
- Minimum required: around €50 per day (not less than €500 total).
- Salary slips or income tax returns can support your application.

7. Travel Medical Insurance

- Mandatory insurance valid for the entire Schengen area + Romania.
- Minimum coverage: €30,000 for medical emergencies and repatriation.

8. Proof of Employment or Study

Depending on your status:

- Employed: No-objection certificate (NOC) from employer, last 3 months' payslips.
- Self-employed: Company registration certificate, business license, tax documents.
- Student: Letter from your school/university confirming enrollment and permission to travel.

9. Cover Letter

- Signed personal letter explaining:
 - Purpose of visit (tourism)
 - Duration of stay
 - Planned travel itinerary
 - Who will cover expenses (you or sponsor)

10. Civil Status Documents (if applicable)

- Marriage certificate, birth certificate (for minors), or family relationship proof if traveling together.

11. Visa Fee Payment

- Visa fee: €80 (approx. ₹7,200) for adults.
- Payment method as per Embassy/Consulate instructions.

12. Appointment Confirmation

- Proof of your interview appointment at the Romanian Embassy/Consulate.
- Some applicants may need to submit biometric data (fingerprints).

Important Notes

- Apply at least 2–3 weeks before your travel date.
- Visa validity: Up to 90 days in any 180-day period.
- Romania is not yet part of Schengen, but accepts valid Schengen multiple-entry visa holders for short stays.
